Using our datasets, we want YOU to show us your insights and data visualizations that use the City of Charleston's Open Data in ways that can inspire and educate your fellow Charleston residents. Create a visualization or map within the Open Data Portal itself, download the data and make something in your preferred visualization tool or send us a description of something you found out about the data you reviewed. Both new and existing projects will be considered.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All submissions are due by Friday, February 10th at 11:59pm, and must include the following:

- Title of project
- Author(s) name
- Primary contact information
- Email address
- Phone number
- Organization name (if applicable)
- City of Charleston Open Data used (please include citations)
- A brief description of the project
- A high-resolution digital image file or URL (must be publicly accessible)
- One thumbnail of your project: One (1) full width or one
 (1) close-up (to show map or app detail)

All projects will be reviewed and notifications for selected projects will be sent out by February 17th with further information. Accepted entries will be displayed on the City's Open Data online gallery and you will have the opportunity to make a brief presentation on your project during our Open Data Day program on Friday, March, 3rd. For Open Data Day, the City of Charleston is seeking insights and data visualizations using our Open Data Portal that can inspire and help your fellow Charleston residents.
